DAY 1

Johannesburg - Kalahari Desert

The Khwai area is teeming with birdlife and wild animals. We enjoy early morning and late afternoon game drives.

DAY 4 - 5

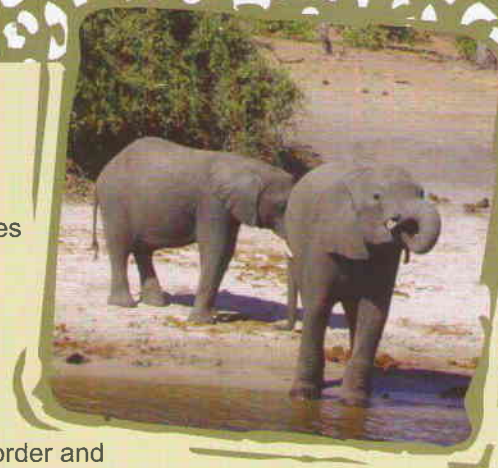
Namib Naukluft Park, Sesriem and the dunes at Sossuvlei

We travel across the Zambian border to view Victoria Falls - one of the most spectacular sights in Africa. Enjoy the

local markets, experience the optional activities, including white water rafting, bungi jumping, micro-lighting / airplane or helicopter over the Falls, rhino walks, elephant back safaris.

Chobe River – Kasane

Camp is set up on the banks of the Chobe River. Chobe is famous for its beautiful scenery, magnificent sunsets and abundance of wildlife and birdlife.



DAY 12

Makgadikgadi Salt Pans, Nata Bird Sanctuary
